MOTORCYCLE AWARENESS PROGRAM
CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

There are two methods to become certified as a M.A.P. Instructor in Oregon.

The first method:

1. Observe a Motorcycle Awareness Program.
2. Obtain the instructional packet from the State Education Director. Contact information is located in your State A.B.A.T.E. Newsmagazine.
3. Learn the material.
4. Attend first presentation as Instructor #1 with a certified instructor.
5. Attend second presentation as Instructor #2 with a certified instructor.
6. Submit your signed certification to the State Education Director.

The second method:

1. Attend a certification class held by the State Education Director. At this class you will receive and review the instructional packet. A training version of the MAP presentation will be given.
2. Participate in a M.A. P. presentation as Instructor #2.
3. Submit your signed certification to the State Education Director.

Upon completion you will receive a M.A.P. Instructor certificate and a rocker identifying you as qualified instructor in this program.

Your responsibilities are to maintain a profession demeanor when making these presentations. While sticking to the outline and maintaining the integrative of the program, you may make slight modifications to the presentation to accommodate the location and experience level of your class. Please be sure to submit your presentation report to your State Board Representative and/or the State Education Director.
